*This study received the approval of O'VIVE consultancy ethical committee and of Shanghai TCM Hospital prior to starting it. Diabetic peripheral neuropathy is a significant source of disability and medical cost. The aim of this study was to assess the effectiveness of adding acupuncture to the Chinese medical footbath Lavipeditum in improving blood perfusion, balancing sympathetic and parasympathetic nervous system (Yin-Yang energy), to eventually reduce the pain of DPN.*
