Short Presentation

My areas of expertise include EU Constitutional Law, the Area of Freedom, Security and Justice, and the protection of Human Rights by the European Union and the European Convention on Human Rights. I am professor of European Law and Human Rights at the UCLouvain – Saint - Louis – Bruxelles, where I am member of the *Centre interdisciplinaire de recherches en droit constitutionnel et administratif*, and of the Institute for European Studies. I am also a research associate both at the Belgian National Fund for Scientific Research (F.R.S.- FNRS) and at the Institute for European Law of the KU Leuven. I have been elected Co-President of the Belgian Association for EU Law (BEDER).

I teach courses on EU Law and the Area of Freedom, Security and Justice at the UCLouvain Saint-Louis – Bruxelles. In addition, I teach a course on the protection of the rule of law and mutual trust in the European Union at the Université libre de Bruxelles.

Previously, I have been a *re:constitution* fellow, working on the protection of the rule of law and judicial independence in Europe. I have also been a post-doctoral researcher at the KU Leuven Institute of European Law, where I was part of the ERC *Reshuffle* project focusing on the protection of fundamental rights by the European Union.

I hold a PhD from both the Université libre de Bruxelles and the Université Saint-Louis Bruxelles (*Le principe de confiance mutuelle en droit de l'Union européenne à l'épreuve d'une crise des valeurs*), completed under a mandate from the Belgian National Fund for Scientific Research (FNRS). My PhD received the **Jean Carbonnier Prize** from the Institute for Studies and Research on Justice and Law (French Ministry of Justice), the **Alice Seghers Prize** from the Université libre de Bruxelles, and the **Pierre-Henri Teitgen Prize** from the French Association for European Studies. It is published in French (2020) and English (2022) with the publishing house Bruylants-Larcier, and has been reviewed in the *Common Market Law Review* (2022, pp. 1239-1243).

I earned an LL.M in European Law from the College of Europe (mention *very good*, as a Baillet-Latour scholar), a Master's degree in Law from the Université libre de Bruxelles (*summa cum laude*, major de promotion, Ganshof Van Der Meersch Prize), and a Bachelor's degree in Law from the Université Saint-Louis – Bruxelles (*magna cum laude*).
